Use this guide to space violin fingering tapes (for a full sized, 4/4 violin), or to replace worn fingering tapes as needed.

Cut along the top edge of the green line and down the right edge of the spaced lines.

Place the green line against the end of the fingerboard underneath the strings.

Mark lightly with a pencil on the fingerboard at each Finger line.

Apply a thin strip (1/8" to 1/4") of tape at each pencil mark under the strings.

Advanced students may use blue markers to help with upper positions.
